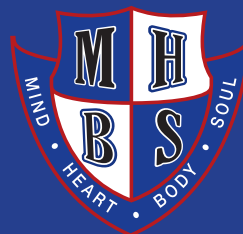

Computer camp will focus on the enhancement of the much-neglected skills of public presentation and speaking. Technology can act as a simple tool to enhance the speaker's confidence and ability. We will focus on independently creating Power Point and Prezi presentations. Students will independently create two presentations: one using Power Point and one utilizing Prezi. Presentations will exhibit how the spoken word differs from the written word. We will emphasize aspects of public speaking such as: verbal and nonverbal communication, clarity, believability, and audience engagement. We will focus on using technology to assist the speaker with guidance and pacing. The goal is to enhance students' confidence in speaking in front of others, as well as to learn how to independently use technological software common to middle school projects.
