ADMISSIONS PROCEDURES & INFORMATION 2023-24

What do you need to know? **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Grades TK-12: A registration fee of \$100 per child is due with the application. The registration fee for returning students will increase to \$150 per child on April 4. Registration fees are non-refundable.

TK: Applicants must be four years old by September 1, 2023.

Kindergarten: Applicants must be five years old by September 1, 2023.

Grades 2-12:

- Transfer students must supply a copy of report cards for last reporting period and a Letter of Good Standing from their previous school.
- Satisfactory conduct records are required.
- Students applying to enter MHBS through transfer should be in good standing (i.e., a 70 average or above in every academic subject and a record of cooperation with school policies) at the school from which they transfer.
- All new students are on academic and conduct probation for one year and must maintain satisfactory academic, conduct, and work habits in order to be enrolled the following year.
- Students and parents must agree to abide by school policies and regulations.

Ready to get started? **ADMISSION PROCEDURES**

Returning families:

- Complete enrollment packet through your FACTS Family Portal and submit registration fee.

New and transfer students:

- Complete application and submit registration fee.
- Complete enrollment packet. The enrollment packet will require submission of:
 - Birth certificate
 - Immunization certificate
 - Copy of last report card
 - Letter of Good Standing from previous school. (Transfer students only)
 - Tuition payment plan
- Participate in admissions committee interview.
- Submit signed *Statement of Core Beliefs and Values*.
- Receive notification of admission.
- Students and parents must agree to abide by school policies and regulations.
