

Request for Quote (RFQ)

Background:

The Mars Hill Bible School (MHBS) is a private Christian day school for boys and girls with principal administrative offices located at 698 Cox Creek Pkwy, Florence, AL 35630. The school begins at preschool (including infant care) and continues through elementary, middle and high School. While the campus facilities are roughly divided between these traditional academic boundaries, there are number of common areas (cafeteria, gym, auditorium, sports fields, etc.) used by all of the children, faculty and staff at various times during any day or week. MHBS also participates in a variety of extracurriculars and athletics at all levels, and it is not unusual to have activity on campus after school hours and on weekends.

Schools such as MHBS are by their nature soft targets. However, MHBS leadership is dedicated to monitoring and protecting the school, students, faculty, and staff. While MHBS requires procedures and protocols, professional vigilance/response and focused security technology to accomplish this goal, this Request for Quote (RFQ) is focused on the security technology aspect of this triad. Furthermore, it is reflective of details developed in a security assessment done across the MHBS campus in late 2023. This assessment identified the need for standardized physical solutions across the campus replacing a number of stove-piped systems that service partial areas and that cannot be monitored centrally. (For example, there are several current CCTV systems serving limited locations on campus). In particular, integrated campus-wide CCTV surveillance system with real-time monitoring; an integrated campus-wide access control system; an integrated public address alert system; and employment of bullet proof laminate on select doors and windows.

Funding for security equipment purchase and related renovations/upgrades/modifications, or physical security enhancements to existing structures, is tied to Federal Emergency Management (FEMA) Preparedness Grants acquired by MHBS. Submission and approval for the grants was made in cooperation with the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) which administers the program throughout the state. Please note that all funds used for these projects are subject to oversight and audit at both the federal and state level.

Certified installer must possess an active alarm/access control, and CCTV licensure for the state of Alabama for over 50K project threshold; to install this security solution but might bid the work regardless.

Certified installer will provide 3 working school and church references with contact information for prior installations, and service.

Quote Information and Requirements:

While MHBS is looking for a holistic and integrated solution to cross-campus physical security and supporting technology, we are requesting that Quotes be tied to the technology proposed at each individual location to match the corresponding FEMA grant. Specifically:

- Mars Hill Bible School Pre-School 1230 Mars Hill Road, Florence, AL 35630
- Mars Hill Bible School Elementary School 1216 Mars Hill Road, Florence, AL 35630
- Mars Hill Bible School Middle and High School 1200 Mars Hill Road, Florence, AL 35630

Thus, for each of the Physical Security Technology Areas identified below, three (3) quotes should be developed addressing the specific needs of that particular section of MHBS, while also providing the required campus-wide integration.

All Quotes must include:

- The extended cost of all equipment.
- Cost of any required mounting hardware, material, wiring and cabling.
- Labor and Administrative costs.
- Licensing fees and monitoring costs as applicable.
- All travel or lodging costs associated with installation.
- Descriptions of any manufacturer and/or installer warranties.
- Cyber-security features of proposed systems.
- Information regarding applicant's experience and expertise (including references).
- Plans for training and indoctrination included with purchase/installation.

Physical Security Technology Areas for Quote:

Note: Overhead pictures and floorplans will be provided to all interested bidders. In addition, a redacted copy of the 2023 security assessment can be made available on request.

- <u>Integrated CCTV</u> Upgrade the entire MHBS campus from legacy out-of-the-box videomonitoring and recording systems to a robust, integrated CCTV system (such as Verkada or Open Eye). This upgraded system should be:
 - a. Capable of monitoring movements throughout the interior of all buildings and at critical exterior locations around the campus.

- b. Able to support partitions for monitoring within each particular academic segment and associated common use and specialized areas (gym, band, administration, auditorium, etc.)
- c. Designed to leverage wireless technology to the greatest extent possible.
- d. With a 30 day video storage capacity
- e. Capable of remote monitoring from personal smart devices and computers for key personnel.
- 2. <u>Integrated Door Access Control</u>: Upgrade select MHBS entry doors to a standardized digital access control system. The new system should include:
 - a. Full integration with the upgraded CCTV.
 - b. Programming capability based on time.
 - c. Capability for "at door" control by fob, card, biometric, and/or keypad entry (please describe).
 - d. Remote control capability for select users.
 - e. Include audible alarms and digital alerts when triggered.
- 3. <u>Integrated Intercom System</u> Install an active alert intercom system for the entire campus that can support fire drills, medical emergencies, lock downs and/or other emergency situations. The system should:
 - a. Have multiple controls provided at select offices or administrative areas.
 - b. Include both campus-wide and academic area segmenting capability.
- 4. <u>Ballistic Laminate</u> Install 35 mil ballistic laminate to reinforce the glass on select entry doors and associated windows.

In the table below, specific items needed to build out these capabilities are listed. This table is intended as a reference in providing quotes that are comparable. Deviations from the list are allowed, but should be explained in terms of capability and/or expected performance.



Wall Mount Pendant – Qty 1 – 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch thread – roughly 12inch arm Ceiling Mounted Pole – Qty 6 – 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch thread – roughly 9 inches Wall mount dome cameras – Qty 8 – Roughly 8 inches out from wall Corner mount dome – Qty 1

Magnetic Lock or interchange Strike lock in price

Push to exit, lit green ADA compliant.

Motion driven request to exit, PIR.

Card reader, 26 bit format, non-encrypted

Fobs – 10 pack prox cards – wallet initial quote

Brackets, materials, bits, programming and necessary materials for functioning door
